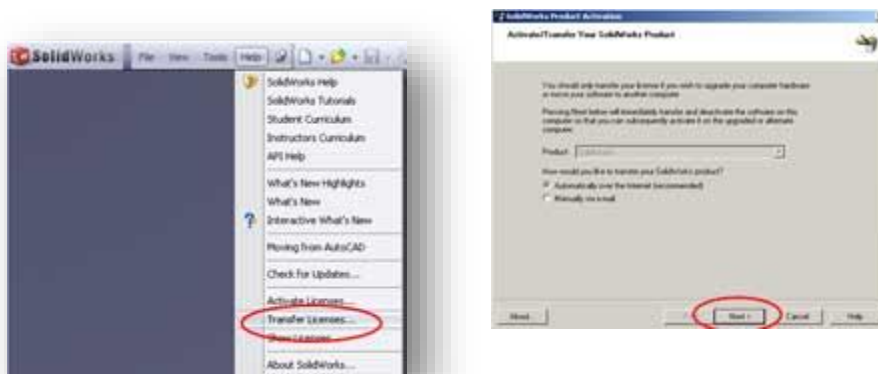


# Removal of copies of SolidWorks installed in error and replaced with the SDK

**Questions:** I gave students the school code for the SolidWorks software in error for students to install the SDK on their computers. How do I rectify the situation so that the SolidWorks licence is returned to the school and the students have the correct SDK code installed on their computer?

**Answer:**

Before you change SolidWorks installation on the Student machine you will need to retrieve the School licence from the computer. Open SolidWorks and in the Help drop down menu select Transfer licence as shown. When you transfer the licence you are deactivating the software on that particular machine.



The easiest way to rectify your problem is to now Modify the SolidWorks installation on the students computers. This can be achieved by going to Add/Remove Programs section of the Control Panel of the computer. Locate SolidWorks from the list of installed programs and select Change as shown.



A SolidWorks screen will appear requesting the code used to install the software as shown. Insert the correct SDK code received from SolidWorks for the SDK installation and follow the instructions.
